



CHALET INFORMATION AND RULES

This is our personal family vacation home. We hope you will treat it as if it were your own and respect all aspects of being able to enjoy our beloved lake tahoe.

This is an exclusive private community. Parking on the street not permitted. Guests that cannot park at chalet must park down the street at the clubhouse. The clubhouse is located across the street and 3 doors down. The gameroom, pool, hot tub, sauna, etc is available to all owners, renters and guests. There is a special guest pool pass and key that must be used to enter. Charge for lost key is \$25.

Please report any damage to property, its contents, malfunctions or mechanical failures promptly upon arrival. We will make every reasonable effort to make repairs as quickly as possible. No refunds or rebates will be issued for malfunctions or mechanical failures.

- Maximum occupancy 25 - 10 persons overnight
- Please park in driveway parking on the street not permitted during snow removal season.
- Please use caution when grilling. Charcoal grills are not to be left unattended. Do not put charcoals in propane grill.
A \$100 charge will apply if charcoals are found in propane grills.
- Please do not flush any non-disposable items down toilet
- No pets permitted unless specified
- No smoking in the cabin, smoking permitted outside. Please do not toss butts, your security deposit will be forfeited if trash or cigarette butts are left outside.
- No tolerance for littering.
- Do not pour grease down sinks.
- Please do not flush any non-disposable items down the toilet.

Items you may want to bring - toilet paper, paper towels, garbage bags, additional towels, certain baking or cooking dishes, laundry soap and shampoo. Our home is equipped with 10 sets of towels, 2 complimentary rolls of toilet paper in each bathroom and 1 roll of paper towels. If you feel this may not be enough for your needs you might want to bring any additional items.

Upstairs loft - pool table is for the enjoyment of all but parents please lesson children on the importance of keeping the felt table clean and not torn. Pool sticks are to be kept in rack on wall and table covered when not in use. No food, drink or clothing on table. The bunk beds are for everyone, but please no climbing or jumping. Horse play can be dangerous up high in this loft. Keep an eye on small children who can fall!
